Feminine Wear

Business Casual

- *Casual Slacks (e.g. khakis)
- *Shirt (e.g. blouse)
- *Socks
- *Casual Shoes

Business Professional

- *Dress Skirt or Dress Slacks
- *Dress Blouse, Dress, or Collared Dress Shirt
- *Ascot, Scarf, or Necktie with a Collared Shirt
- *Socks or Hosiery
- *Shoes (Heels must be no taller than 3 inches)
- *Blazer (Not mandatory at the state level. However, it makes for a more professional look. The official DECA blazer cannot be worn)

Note

- *Feminine wear may be worn by all genders.
- *In the case that a religious headscarf is worn, an ascot/scarf/necktie is not required when wearing a collared dress shirt.
- *Skirts and Dresses should be worn below the knee

- *Socks
- *Casual Shoes

Business Professional

- *Dress Slacks
- *Collared Dress Shirt
- *Necktie
- *Dress Shoes
- *Dress Socks
- *Blazer (Not mandatory at the state level. However, it makes for a more professional look. The official DECA blazer cannot be worn)

Note

- *Masculine wear may be worn by all genders.
- *Boat Shoes and Loafers are NOT considered dress shoes
